For the information of the Bureau, on 7/14/66, [redacted] was apprehended by the Chicago Office on the basis of an indictment returned 6/30/66, by the FGJ, Eastern District of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, charging [redacted] and four other subjects with violating Title 18, Section 1952, U.S. Code (ITAR - EXTORTION) in the shakedown of [redacted] in Philadelphia on 8/6/65.

[redacted] appeared before U.S. Commissioner C. S. BENTLEY PIKE, Chicago, on 7/14/66, at which time Commissioner PIKE advised him of his constitutional rights and appointed a public defender as [redacted] counsel. Arraignment in this matter was continued until 7/20/66.

On 7/20/66, while in Commissioner PIKE's hearing chambers, [redacted] informed a Bureau Agent, in the presence of his attorney, that he desired to speak with the Agent. [redacted] was firmly advised by the Agent and subsequently by the AUSA handling the matter that [redacted] would not, and could not, be interviewed without the expressed consent of his attorney. When the Commissioner called the case, [redacted] arose and stated that he desired to speak with the FBI Agent prior to being arraigned. The AUSA then objected, telling the Commissioner that he refused to allow the FBI Agent to interview [redacted] unless his attorney agreed to same. The commissioner then inquired of [redacted] attorney whether he was agreeable to his client being interviewed by the FBI and the attorney, a former AUSA, replied "No, no client of mine will ever be interviewed by the FBI". When [redacted] persisted in his request to be interviewed his attorney stated, "I won't allow my client to be interviewed, if he wants to be interviewed then let him get another attorney". The Commissioner then requested [redacted] to approach his bench and asked him [redacted]

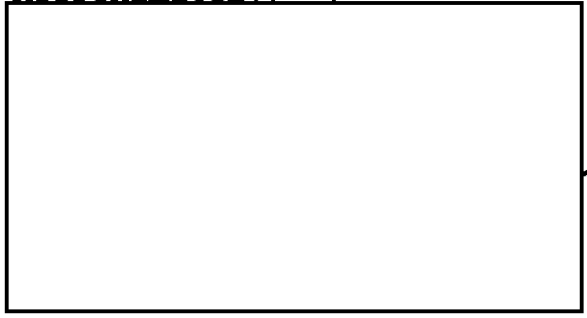
