Townland names are in Irish spelling, English "translation" but not the meaning and Irish Script. From "A Collection of History and Heritage of Kilcar" by the Aislann Cill Chartha, 1995; a list of townlands in Griffith Valuation 1857 and the Baptismal Record for Kilcar, 1848 to 1910. The list is in order of the first letter of the Irish word to facilitate lookup from the Script in the Baptismal record. Some townlands have not been identified in the Baptismal record. Some families were living outside of the Parish of Kilcar at the time of the baptism of the child and so that outside townland is listed. It is likely that a few of the names are localities other than townlands. A formal list of townlands is also included.
