

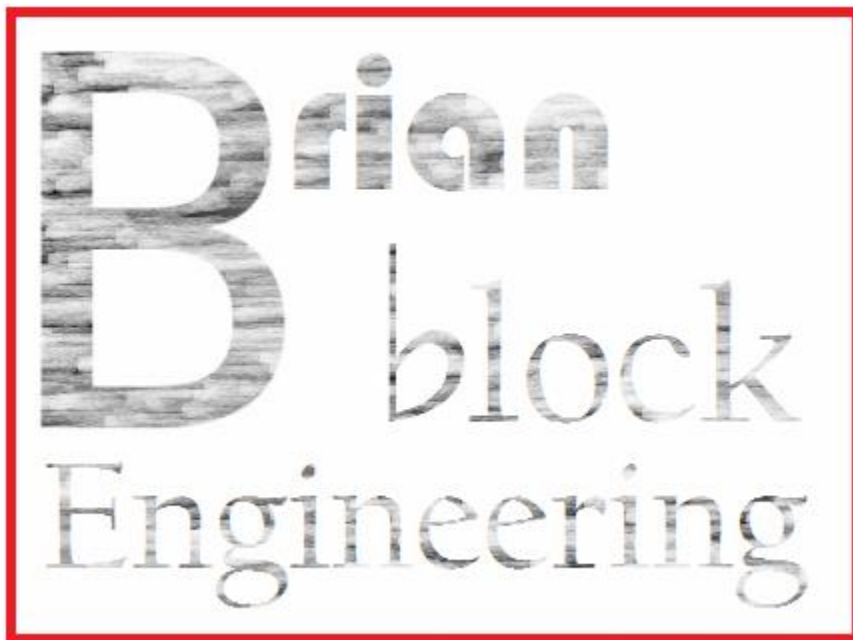

Design Concept

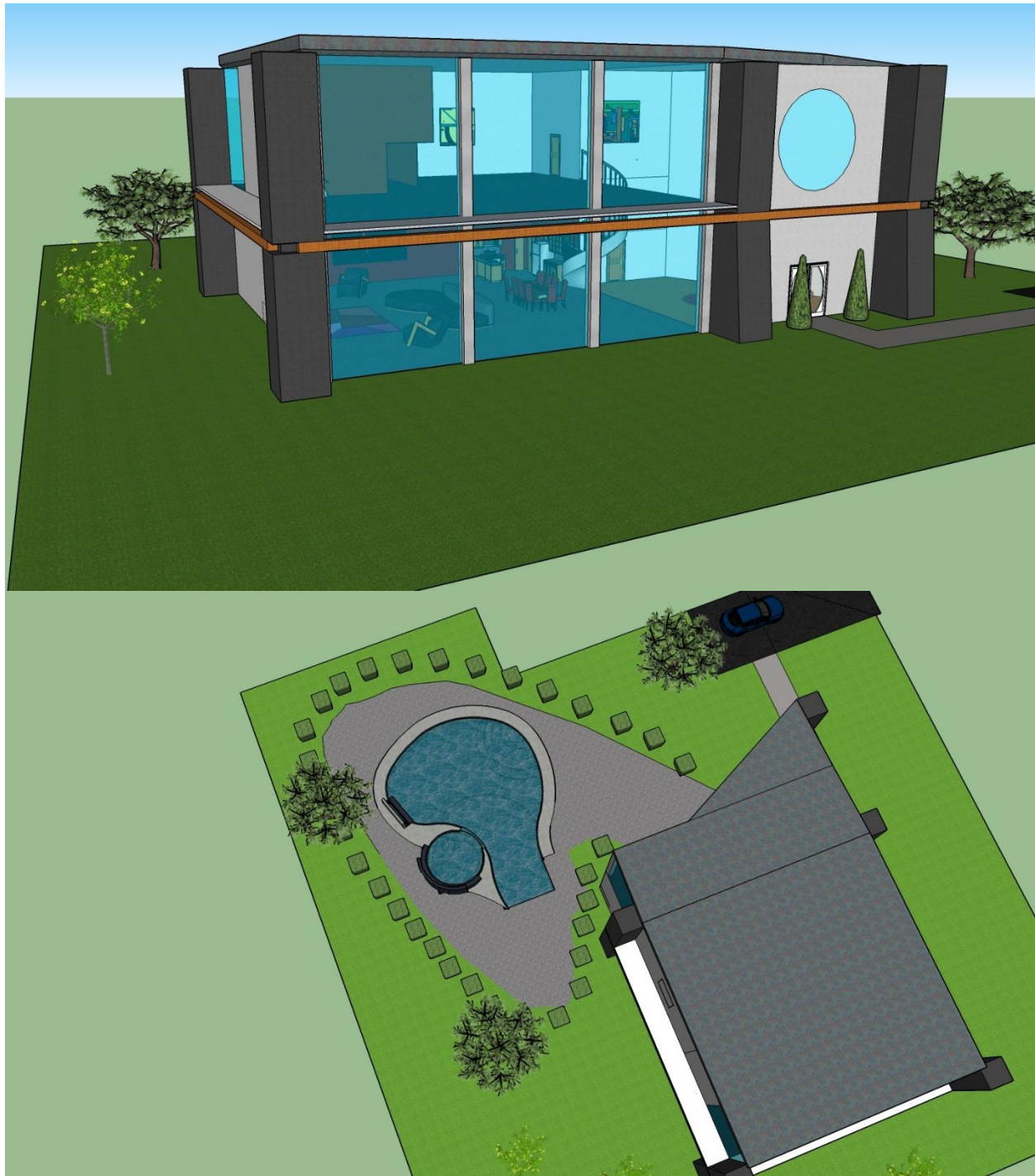

From the front the stark black pillars stand out against the white stucco sides and the big floor to ceiling windows. This contrasting look favors the contemporary style. As the client wanted, the house has a very open floor plan with many options for furniture arrangement and style. The location of all the furniture and appliances placed in the house is a suggestion from the BBEE design team, but the client has the freedom to rearrange things to his choosing. The color scheme is primarily white, red, and black. The house is plenty big enough for the client and his family. It is located in the outskirts of San Diego, where the client currently resides.

- A really cool something unusual or unique, but appropriate, in the design.

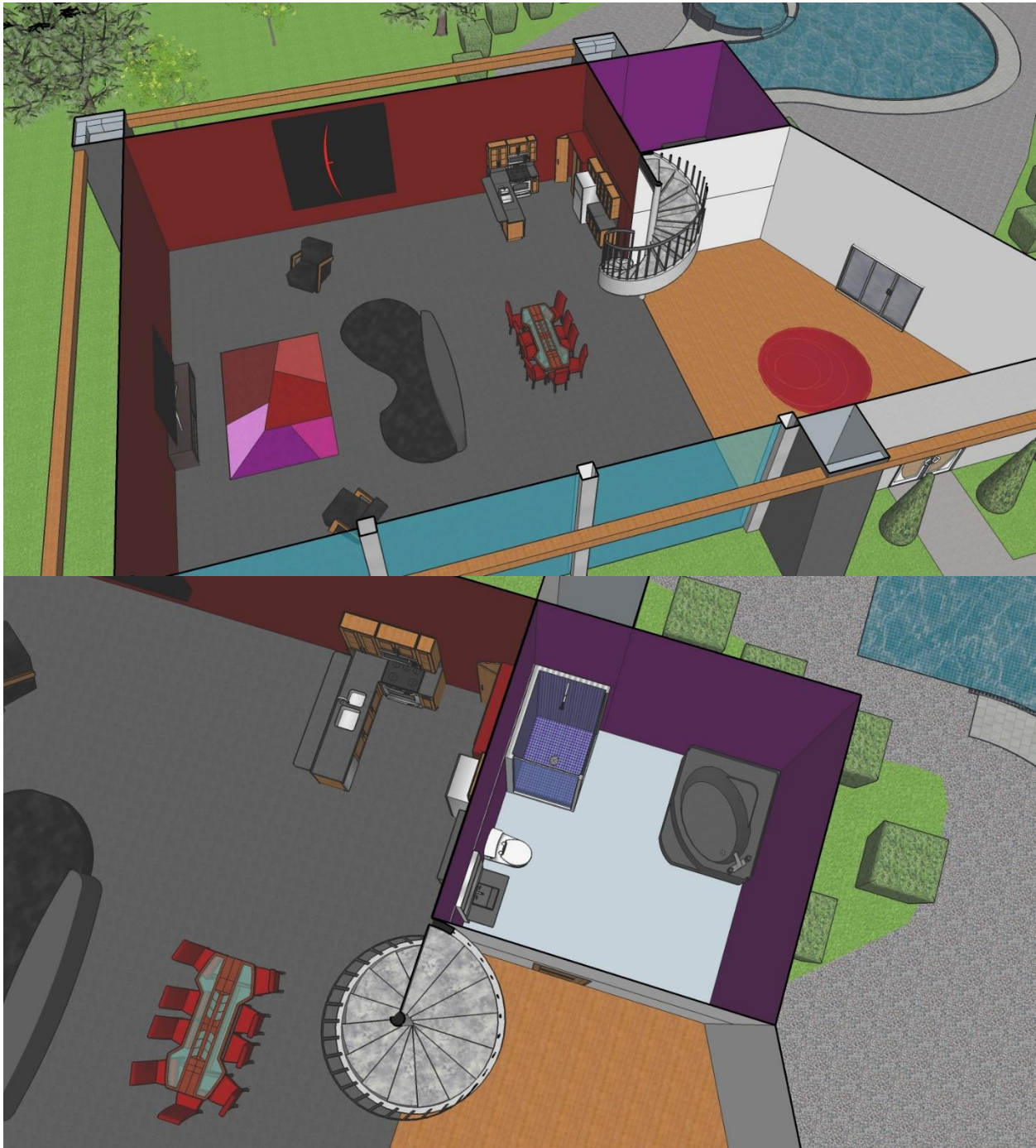

Exterior View



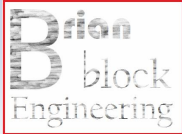
Interior View
