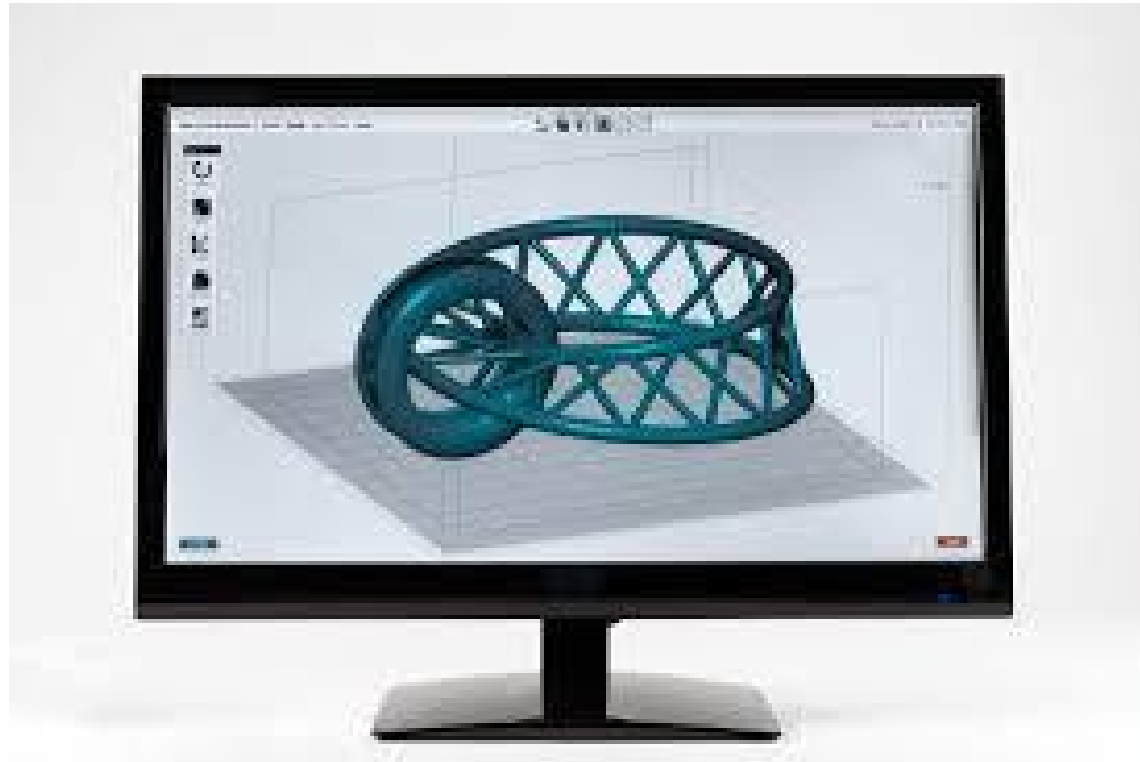

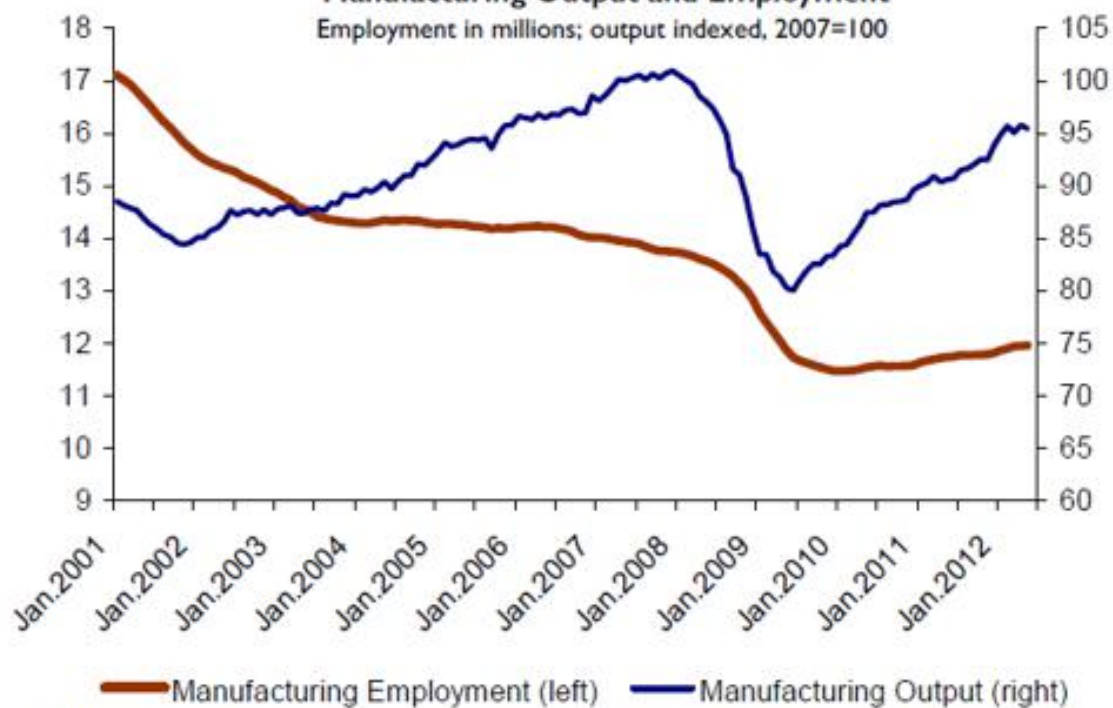

### Manufacturing Output and Employment

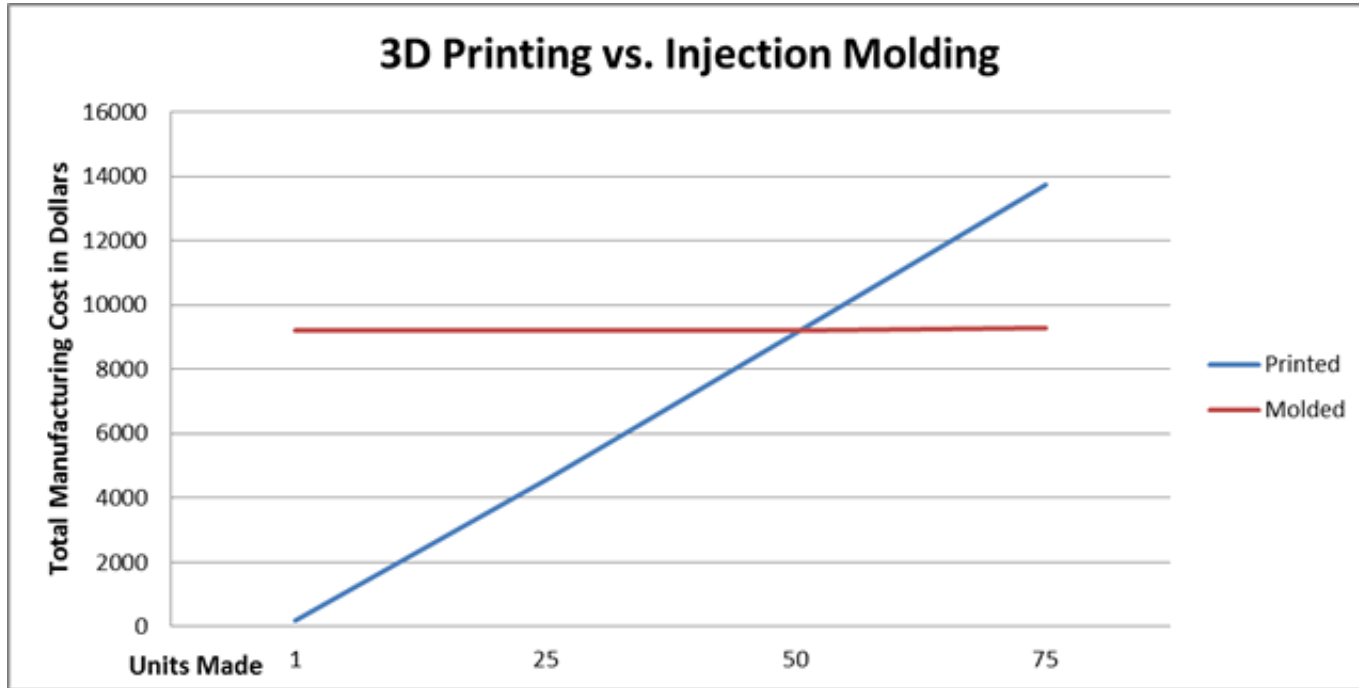
Employment in millions; output indexed, 2007=100

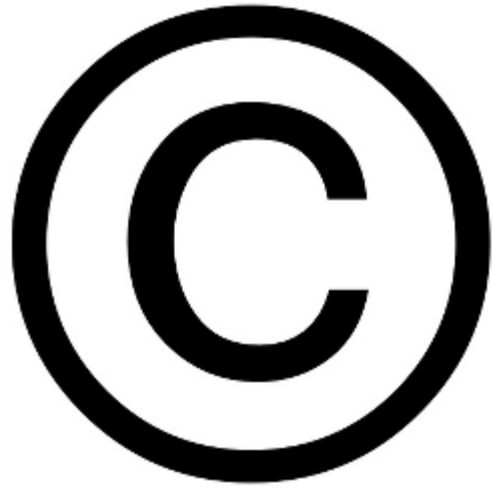
