Commented [MPA3]: If you attended another university of college, place that information here. Generally, high schools are not listed on resumes.

Commented [MPA4]: Other common sections that are similar to this one are “Special Skills” or “Computer Skills”

Commented [MPA5]: On this template, most lists are kept to two, three, or four items. However, you might have good reason such as a large number of honors or awards to exceed that number. With lists, make sure that the items are listed in a parallel fashion. If the first item is a verb phrase, all items in that list should be verb phrases.

Commented [MPA6]: If you do not have a third position worthy of being on the resume, then delete this entry and provide more information about the two you have.

Commented [MPA7]: The purpose of this section is to give an interviewer an ice-breaker at the beginning of an interview. For that reason, be prepared to talk about these activities when you interview. Also, if you are looking for a section to cut to fit your resume onto one page, then cut this section. Other possible sections to cut would be “Activities” and “Relevant Courses.” In regard to space, if you do go to a second page, then make sure you come close to filling that second page. One means for doing so would be to write the resume in 12 point type, rather than 10 point type.
