### Exterior View



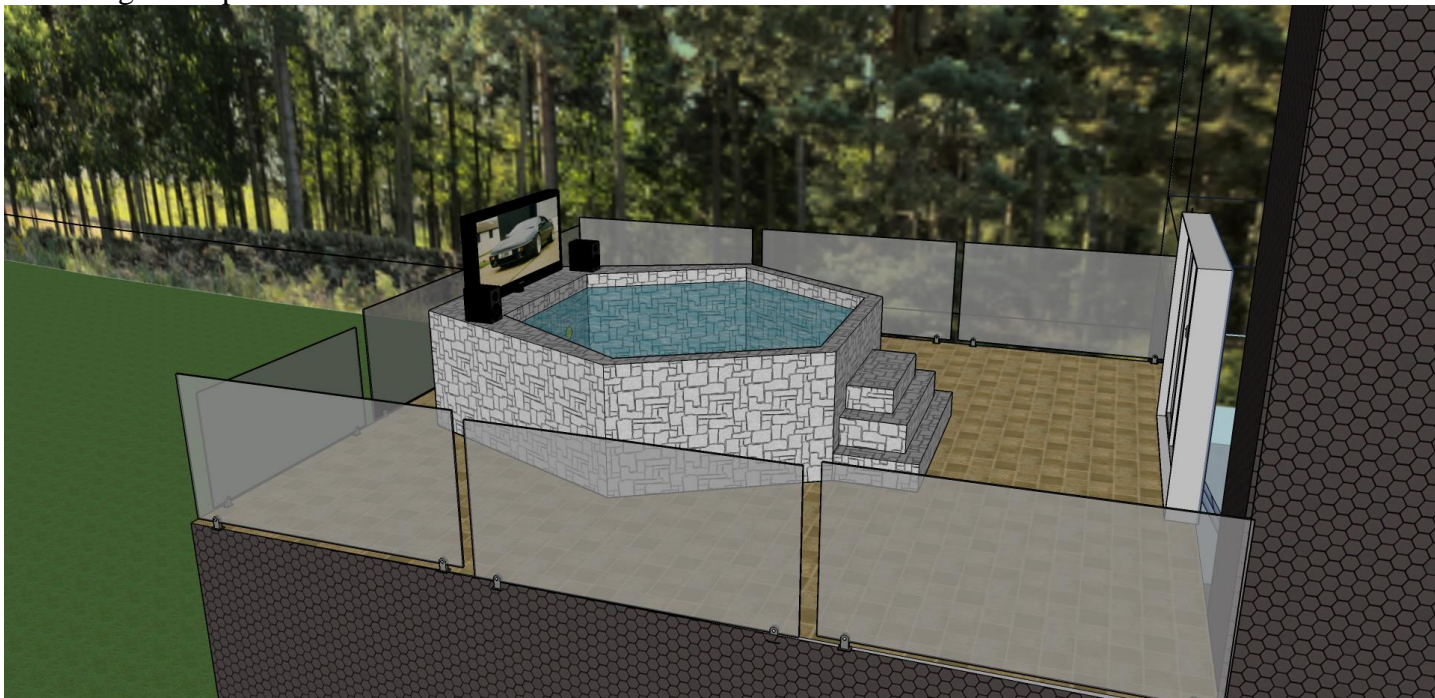
