

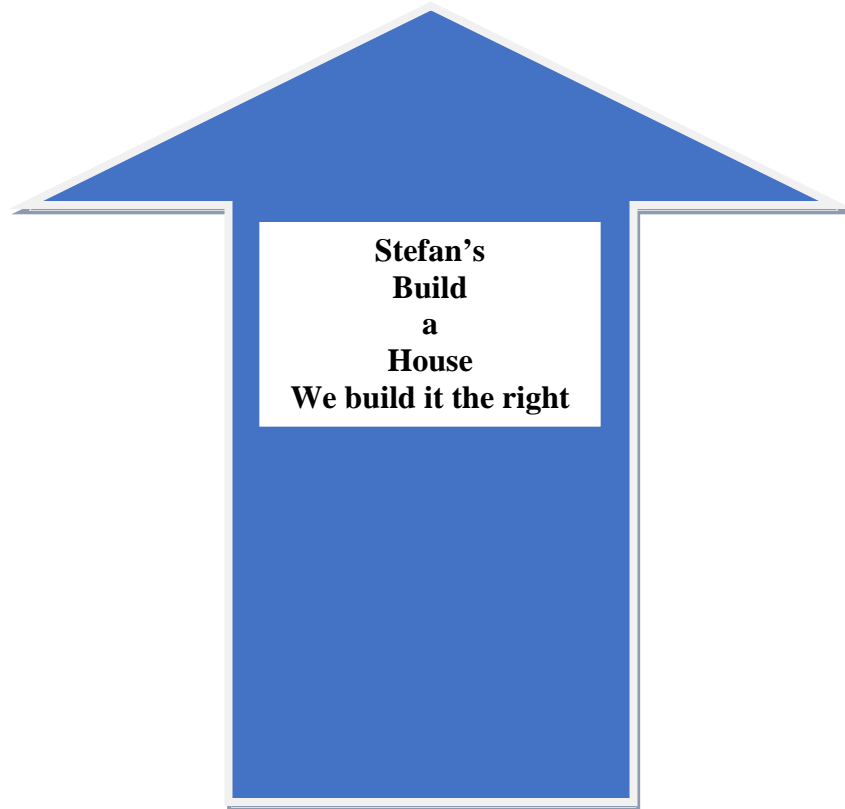

Concept Design Report

Background

The project called for a house to be built with at least 4 to 5 rooms for a client. This house also needed to have a landscape with trees, plants, a driveway, and a sidewalk. At least six windows were to be included with two exterior doors and the walls were meant to have a thickness to show realism. By using the drawing tools along with the shaping tools allowed for the frame of the house to be drawn. The other elements including all of the fixtures were imported from the warehouse. Color changes were made to the house with the paint tool as well as the driveway, pool, lawn, and roof.

Design Concept

The house was built with a concept that fit the requirements that the client listed with some additional elements. The house included a kitchen, one bedroom, one bathroom, an office, a living room, a dining room, and a garage on the inside. On the outside it included a driveway, landscape, pool/patio and a sidewalk. This design is ideally meant for a couple with no kids who might be older in age and want to spend their time relaxing by a pool. The color concept of the outside and inside of the house is very traditional with no exuberant colors used. The wall color matches the wooden floors and also the window framing.

This house is located in a residential area that has a warmer climate. A warmer climate is needed to have a pool and the excellent lawn and flowers suggest a nice climate.

Components of the Project

- Minimum 4-5 rooms (living room, kitchen, bathroom, bedroom, dining room, etc.)¹. Include at least six windows and two exterior doors².
- Furniture as needed, such as beds, sinks, dressers, couches, tables, chairs, TVs, etc. The more you include the better³.
- All components of my house, including walls⁴, roof⁵, doors, windows, etc. must be coordinated by style, texture and color.
- A lawn and scaled shrubs that completely surrounds the house.
- At least three different type trees/shrubs in the yard.
- An exterior patio, pool, Jacuzzi, play area, tennis courts, putting green, etc., etc.

As seen by the exterior of the house, the siding on the house is a light gray siding that matched the darker gray shingled roof. The roof has a circular window in the center that is great for gazing at stars while eating. A pool with a patio sits out back of the house with a back door leading right onto the patio. The driveway is located on the left side of the house and is a two car garage. Four windows line the front of the house along with two flower beds. There are a few trees around the property including two cherry blossoms.

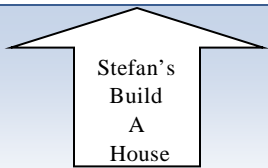
Interior View
